Brothers and Sisters,

As we announced during April's NATCA meeting, regarding the election protest and the possibility of a special election, we are contacting you with the latest developments.

During the first review of the nominated candidates for this term, we followed the NATCA national election guidelines for determining the eligibility of nominees. However, we received information regarding a pending protest of our selection process, so we sought advice from the NATCA Executive Vice President. Then, on the advice of the VP, we proceeded with the election as originally planned, with the caveat that a protest might have to be sorted out later. We did so in good faith. As it subsequently turned out, in the determination of candidate eligibility, the national criteria cannot be followed based on technicality, in the manner that we had interpreted.

We are now proceeding with a new election, as directed by General Council Marguerite L. Graf, in the attached letter.
